Option 1. STUDY SESSIONS

These are short two-hour “cram” sessions specifically targeted to the Accuplacer® test. Students register by paying \$10 per session at Registration in BATC Student Services.

[NOTE: If BATC’s registration is closed, payment should be made at BATC in Room 604 or at the study session with \$10 cash or a \$10 check to BATC, not with credit or debit cards.]

* A review of *both* college level math *and* trigonometry may significantly boost your score and is highly recommended for anyone needing the College Level Math test. Both subject areas are especially important to place into Math 1100/2020 or Stat 2000/2300 or higher.

Option 2. SELF-PACED WITH TUTORING LAB

Do you want some extra help? Review your math more completely for that next test.

- **Just \$48 per block.** Register for “Academic Learning” either in person at BATC Student Services or by phone (435-753-6780). The cost is \$48 for a four-week block of study.
- **Gain access.** You will have access to the Academic Learning Center’s lab. This includes access to course materials and access to tutors in the lab who can help you with individual questions. Later, you would pay another \$48 if you decide you want another four weeks.

The lab is open:

M, T, W, Th 8 am to 8 pm

Friday 8 am to 4 pm

Remember we close early on Fridays!

These are the same times that we are open for Accuplacer® testing.

Don’t rush yourself!

You should arrive before 6:30 pm (Mon-Thurs) or before 2 pm (Friday afternoon) to give yourself time to finish the test.

If you arrive after these times, you may not have enough time to take the test.

Tests must be finished by closing time.
