



## Not Pell Eligible – EFC



When you submit your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) your results are released to the schools of your choice in the form of an ISIR, *Institutional Student Information Record*. Bridgerland Technical College has received your ISIR.

One indication of eligibility for the Pell Grant is determined by the EFC number that is found on the ISIR. EFC stands for Expected Family Contribution and is a measure of how much the student and his or her family can be expected to contribute to the cost of the student's education for the year. The EFC is calculated according to a formula specified in the law.

Your EFC exceeds the limit defined for Pell Grant eligibility. **You are not eligible to receive the Pell Grant** for the current year. *It is not necessary for you to complete any other documents the College may have requested with this notice. If you submitted documents previously, this notice may have come to you as a result of corrections already made by the school.*

You may be eligible for other sources of financial aid for your enrollment at Bridgerland. If you are concerned that your EFC does not accurately reflect your financial situation review the answers you reported on the FAFSA.



If you have not already submitted documents to the Financial Aid Office and you find any errors on your FAFSA be sure to correct them. A new ISIR will be sent to Bridgerland and will be evaluated. Review your ISIR and make corrections on-line at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov).

*Please note: You must submit all other documents requested with this notice to the Bridgerland Financial Aid Office. Additional documentation may also be required as a result of any changes you make.*

If you previously submitted documents to the Financial Aid Office, it is likely that corrections were already made by the school – please contact Bridgerland’s Financial Aid Office before making any further changes or corrections on your FAFSA. Additional documentation may be required as a result of any changes you make and may or may not affect your Pell eligibility status.
