## **Do you have a Bachelor's Degree? Are you Eligible for the Federal Pell Grant?**

When you filled out the FAFSA, you answered questions about the highest level of education you have completed. One question asks what degree or certificate you will be working on as you begin the current award year. Another question asks if you will have your first bachelor's degree before July 1, of the current award year.



Your answers to one or both of these questions indicate that you have received a bachelor's degree or are working on a degree beyond a bachelor's degree. Students who have a bachelor's degree are not eligible to receive a Federal Pell Grant.
