TRANSCRIPT INFORMATION

The Utah System of Higher Education is comprised of eight public universities and eight technical colleges and governed by the Utah Board of Higher Education. The Utah State Legislature founded Bridgerland in September of 1971.

Bridgerland Technical College instructional programs are typically offered in an open-entry/open-exit environment and are competency based. This means program enrollment and completion dates are flexible and designed to meet individual student needs. Students are able to progress through instructional programs as skills and competencies are mastered. Instructors monitor completion time and evaluate student performance.

Certificates

Bridgerland offers a Certificate credential program completion directly related to preparing individuals for entry-level employment in current or emerging occupations.

Grade Point Average is calculated on Graded Coursework only, and is weighted by the number of Clock/Credit Hours for each course according to the following values: A (or 4) 4.0, A- 3.7, B+ 3.3, B (or 3) 3.0, B- 2.7, C+ 2.3, C (or 2) 2.0, C- 1.7, D (or 1) 1.0, D- 0.7, F (or 0) 0.0 (n/a -letter grade not applicable.)

Associate of Applied Technology (AAT) Degree

The AAT Degree was a competency-based associate degree offered from September 2002 through June 2012. Students graduated with course work equivalent to 63 semester credit hours, based upon a 30-clock hour to 1 semester credit hour formula. The Utah State Board of Regents, the Utah System of Higher Education governing board at the time, approved all AAT degrees.

FORMAL DISCIPLINARY ACTION

Dismissal

The removal of a student from enrollment at the college and may occur for persistent violation of college rules or for a single offense of marked severity.

Formal Disciplinary Action

A Utah System of Higher Education (USHE) institution has investigated and found a student responsible for violations(s) of institutional policies regarding sexual misconduct or sex discrimination and harassment which resulted in either a dismissal or suspension.

Suspension

When a student is denied attendance in class in response to a violation.
