



Pell Grant Eligible Programs

In order for an otherwise eligible institution to participate in Federal Student Aid (FSA) programs it must provide at least one eligible program. A program may be considered eligible if it provides a required number of hours, is offered during a required number of weeks, leads to a certificate, and prepares students for gainful employment in a recognized occupation. Not all programs at an eligible institution qualify as eligible programs.

Note: Students with a Certificate Seeking enrollment objective may qualify. Students whose enrollment objective is Personal Interest, Online, Job Upgrade, or Short-term do not qualify.

*Students beginning in October 2018 or thereafter may choose only this hour value for the indicated program. Students who began programs prior to October 2018 may change enrollment into these programs so long as the change occurs in October 2018 or thereafter. Pell Grant eligibility for these programs effective December 6, 2018.

** Students who began training in January 2018 or later may not select these programs. Students who began training at Bridgerland in November or December 2017 may enroll in and receive Pell Grant funds in these programs. Students may change enrollment into these programs so long as the change into these programs occurred prior to December 14th, 2017

*** Pell Grant eligibility for these programs effective July 31, 2018.
