

Programs Approved for Veterans Education Benefits

The Utah State Approving Agency for Veterans Education approves the education and training of veterans and other eligible persons at Bridgerland Technical College for various certificate programs. Eligible programs may be considered and approved by the Utah State Department of Veterans Affairs if it provides a required number of hours, is offered during a required number of weeks, leads to a certificate or degree, and prepares students for gainful employment in a recognized occupation. All programs have approval of the College's accrediting and state agencies.

Note: Not all programs at an eligible institution qualify as eligible programs. Students with a Certificate Seeking enrollment objective may qualify. Students whose enrollment objective is Basic Skills, Career Advancement, Continuing Education, Personal Interest, or Secondary do not qualify. Online enrollment does not qualify.

Students enrolled in the following certificate programs may be eligible to receive <u>veteran benefits</u> for the hours indicated () by selecting one of the approved certificates listed. <u>Students may only enroll in and receive benefits for programs identified</u>:

*These programs are in "Teach Out" status. Students who began training in October 2018 or later may not select these programs. Students may change enrollment into these programs so long as the change into these programs occurred prior to September 27, 2018.

Veterans and other eligible persons enrolled in the <u>Apprenticeship Program(s)</u> at Bridgerland Technical College may also qualify to receive veteran benefits.
